**Treasurer's Report:**

- **2019 Run to the Home** – PJ Reported the following:
  - There will be three stops for the Scoot and Shoot: Churchtown (Tentative – John Roberts to confirm Pavilion usage with Churchtown) for Darts; Ancram for Paintball; Copake for Corn Hole. The Fireman’s Home will have Horseshoes and Ladderball.
  - The distance of the ride will be contingent upon the weather.
  - Continental Breakfast at the Home.
  - The crew that stays behind will do the shopping for hamburgers, hot dogs, cheese and chips so the purchases can be made based on number of registered attendees rather than an estimate.
  - The home will provide coffee, soda/water, potato salad, baked beans, and plastic/paper items for a small fee.
  - Cost is \$20 per rider and passenger; \$10 for those eating but not riding.
  - Doors open at 9:30am for registration with KSU at 10:30am.
  - The utility trailer will be available in the event of a breakdown.
